Impact on cost:

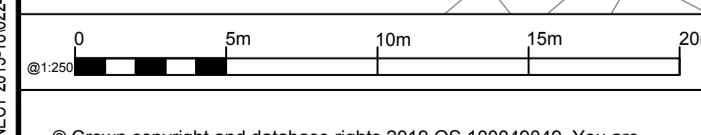
